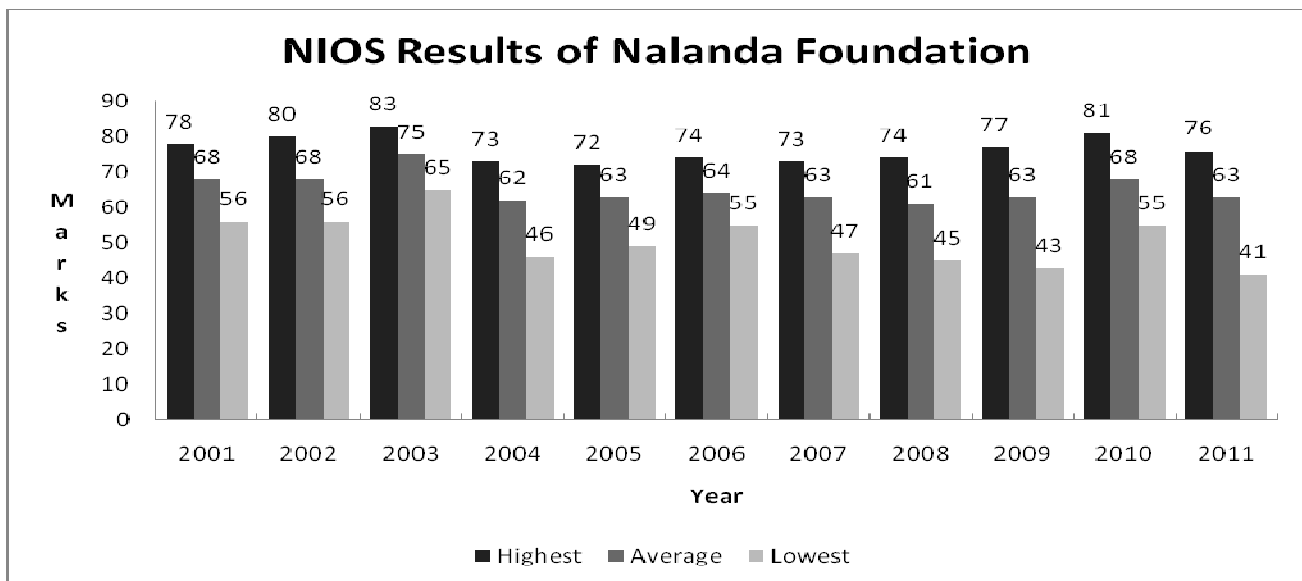

The Nalanda Foundation runs an institute for children who find it difficult to cope in regular mainstream schools. The institute offers educational program for students from Std. V to X. Std. V-VIII follow S.S.C. syllabus. Std. IX -X follow NIOS syllabus. At Std. VIII level students make a choice whether they want to continue with S.S.C or shift to NIOS.

After passing secondary exams (Std. X), students join mainstream colleges in various streams. Our results have been almost 100% with average scores 65% with highest going upto 75-80%





Nalanda Program - Features

The key features of the Nalanda Program are as follows:

- S.S.C curriculum from V-VIII. For IX-X can proceed for S.S.C.E, if the student has LD certificate. Or can change to NIOS IX and X, with or without LD certificate.
- 10-15 students only in each division, air conditioned classrooms.
- Individual attention to students in the class by trained teachers
- Notes & Workbooks prepared by our teachers for our students for NIOS & SSC curriculum. For SSC as per curriculum of the Board with concessions for LD
- 4 internal/unit tests and two term exams
- Open Days for Parents after each exam

NIOS concessions

- Writer available / Additional time of 1 hour for each subject
- Can do staggered NIOS- appear for 2 or 3 subjects every year in April and October.

For students who have obtained LD certificate from authorised centres, (KEM, SION or NAIR Hospital), concessions will be available as per the SSC & NIOS norms
